

Super simple tam for kids

This is a simple pattern for a child or if you want to make an adult tam/beret in soft alpaca. You may use any kind of yarn just measure the diameter before you start to decrease.

Cast on 6 ch and make ring. Crochet 8 tr, the first tr is 3 ch.
Start every round with 3 ch =1st tr.

Row 1: 2 tr in each tr

Row 2: * 1 tr, 2 tr in the same tr*

Row 3: * 2 tr, 2 tr in the same tr*

Row 4: * 3 tr, 2 tr in the same tr*

Increase in this way by increasing +1 tr until the diameter is:

23 cm about 2-3 years

25 cm about 4-5 years

about 30 cm is for the adult

Then crochet 1 tr in every tr, starting each row with 3 ch

2-3 years: 3 rows

4-5 years: 4 rows

Adult about 5 rows

Start to decrease

From now on you crochet dc

Decrease every 6th and 7th tr together

One row no decreasing, dc even

Decrease every 5th and 6th tr together

Continue dc even in

2-3 years 3 cm

for size 4-5 years i decreased another 5 stitches evenly one row

And then dc until 4 cm

Adult dc for 5 cm

Finish with a different color in the last row. Optional.

Weave in ends.

To make it softer to the little ones forehead you might put a lining inside.
